Heritage High School Student Government Campaign Guidelines 2018-19

In order to ensure participants both equal and fair campaigns, we, the current officers and members of Heritage High School's Student Government Association ask that every candidate planning on running for an office position, or membership, follow these campaign guidelines and procedures. Failure to follow protocol may result in dismissal from the campaign as determined by administration. The following positions are available for next year:

Freshmen CLASS **NO Experience**
Vice President
Secretary
Communications officer
Members at Large

a. Class officer (President, Vice President, Secretary, or Treasurer)

- i. 50 signatures from student in their OWN grade level
- ii. <u>Recommendation letters (3)</u>
- iii. Ethics Statement and parent signature

b. Members-at-Large

- i. <u>30 signatures from their **OWN** grade level</u>
- ii. <u>Recommendation letters (3)</u>
- iii. Ethics Statement and parent signature

SGA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

Wake County Policy No. 6860 shall apply to students participating in the following activities in grades 7 – 12: Athletics, cheerleading, marching Band, including majorette, flag corps, etc., and student Council Officers and/or executive council

Students participating in the activities above shall comply with the following eligibility requirements:

a. School Academic Requirements:

- Must have passed three subjects each term on a 4x4 block schedule. Note: Summer school grades may be used as part of the minimum load. WCPSS does not allow the year-end finals grades to override a deficiency in the second semester grades on a traditional calendar.
- 2. One of the classes passed must be English on traditional or must be passed as one of the three when taken on 4x4 block. (WCPS).
- 3. Cumulative grade point average must be at least 1.50 (WCPS).

EXCEPTIONS:

- If cumulative GPA is less than 1.5, students may be eligible if
 - a. GPA for immediate preceding semester is at least a 2.0

- b. Student is on track towards graduation
- c. Progress during current semester is at least a 2.0
- d. Principal give approval
- 4. Any student removed from Student Government due failure to meet academic requirements in the current year may not run for a position as an officer for the next year. Such a student may run as a member-at-large.
- B. Student Council Attendance Policy:
 - 1. SGA Monthly Meetings
- ATTENDANCE IS MANDATORY.
- 2. Class Meetings
- ATTENDANCE IS MANDATORY.
- C. Grounds for Dismissal
- Students may be removed from SGA at the discretion of the advisors and the administration. Reasons for dismissal may include, but are limited to:
 - Failure to fulfill the duties assigned to you
 - Excessive absences
 - Failure to represent Heritage High School Student Government in a positive manner through both social media and all other interactions.

You are running for a <u>PUBLIC OFFICE and POSITION OF LEADERSHIP AT HERITAGE HIGH</u> <u>SCHOOL.</u> You are expected to uphold the expectations of Heritage High School, be a positive influence on your classmates, school and community. You will be held accountable for your actions (<u>classes, school functions, community events and social media</u>) as a Student Government Officer and representative of HHS. If you feel you cannot positively represent HHS and SGA, PLEASE do not run for office.

Read and follow the information below to help you in your campaign

Posters

- You are allowed up to 5 campaign posters.
- Posters MUST be pre-approved and initialed by an SGA Advisor (Mr. Bryant, Ms. Lyles, or an administrator) prior to being hung on walls.
- Posters may <u>ONLY</u> be displayed campaign week (Sept. 17th Sept.21st) and <u>MUST</u> be taken down on Friday September 21st.
- Posters MUST be hung <u>within 2 feet</u> of an existing bulletin board (all others will be removed without notice).
- Poster putty or painters tape must be used to protect the integrity of the paint on the walls. They should be hung neatly without ragged blue tape showing.

Any violation of this will be handled by administration

- T-shirts with campaign slogans
- Gifts/Candy/Food/<u>ANYTHING OF VALUE</u> or any other form of bribery for votes
- Pins
- Degrading of other candidates, HHS staff members or students
